



LEAVE RULES

- Students are expected to attend school on the re-opening day after each vacation, those
 absent without leave will be fined at the rate ₹5/- per day of absence and they will be
 marked absent. CBSE rule says any student having less than 75% of attendance is not
 allowed to sit for Final Examination. Those who are absent due to illness must produce a
 medical certificate.
- No leave will be granted except in the case of illness or valid reasons. All applications for leave should be entered in the Diary and signed by Parents/Guardian registered with the school.
- Repeated absence without leave and continued absence from school for more than 7
 days without prior sanction of leave will result in the name being struck off from the rolls.
 Re-admission in such cases will be at the discretion of the Principal and subject to
 payment of fresh admission fee and pending dues.

WITHDRAWALS

- CBSE does not allow student to take XI and XII examination if class compartment is not cleared in first attempt i.e. in the month of July the same year.
- Application for withdrawal of student and issue of School Leaving Certificate should be filled by the Parents/Guardian at least one month in advance in the prescribed form or pay one month tuition fee in lieu of that.
- School fees and other dues should be paid up to the date of leaving the School and a clearance certificate can be obtained from office.
- The School reserves the right to compel the parents to withdraw a student on the under mentioned grounds.
 - a) Irregular attendance
- b) Unsatisfactory academic progress
- c) Bad conduct
- d) Immorality or grave insubordination

SPORTS AND GAMES

The facilities of a swimming pool, vast play ground and trained coaches are available to the students. All children spend one hour daily on games, sports, P.T. or athletics so as to keep them physically fit.

Though all care is taken by the staff to look after the students in the best possible manner, yet the school authorities will not be liable for any damage or injuries, fatal or otherwise, which may be sustained by a student in calisthenic sports, athletics or other co-curricular activities inside the school.

In order to inculcate the spirit of healthy competition and to discover the talents and aptitudes of children, the school has been divided into four Houses:

- SAHIBZADA AJIT SINGH HOUSE
- SAHIBZADA JUJHAR SINGH HOUSE
- SAHIBZADA ZORAWAR SINGH HOUSE
- SAHIBZADA FATEH SINGH HOUSE

Each house is under the care of a house master who is assisted by teachers.

Inter-house competitions are held in academics, sports and other co-curricular activities and prizes are given to the winners.

EXAMINATIONS & PROMOTION

- As per C.B.S.E. recommendations regarding continuous assessment, the school has adopted a system of conducting regular weekly test. On every Wednesday there is a weekly test in the morning for one hour for all classes from K.G. to XII.
- 2. One half yearly examination is held in the month of September and then Final Exam in the month of March for class III to XII.
- 3. No final Exam for classes Nursery to II. Promotion on the basis of weekly Test only.
- 4. Student absent from these examination for any reason, will be re-examined and those absent from all examinations without genuine reason will be considered to have failed. In case of illness during an examination, a medical certificate should be submitted promptly.
- 5. A student who fails twice in same class has to leave the school.
- Students are promoted to higher class on the basis of their performance over the year, hence they need to be regular in their studies throughout the year.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Cash awards are given to all Merit Holders.

MEDICAL & HEALTH SERVICES

- A qualified Doctor is employed by the school to ensure the physical fitness of the students.
- A complete record of medical inspection of students by school Medical Officer is maintained, vaccination and inoculation are arranged as and when required.

SCHOOL CONVEYANCE

BUSTRANSPORT

The school management feels that the children living at some distance from the school should come directly under the school control as soon as they leave parental control everyday. For this purpose bus service is provided by the school. Use of bus service is compulsory in the interest of safety of the children and their reaching the school in time.

SCHOOL LIBRARY

The school has a spacious library. It has latest books and reading material suited for all ages and standards. The record of each child's reading is maintained by the librarian.

Rules of Library

- 1. Reading of library books is encouraged by the teachers. Each student must read at least one book of library in a month.
- 2. A student can borrow only one book at a time.
- 3. If the book is not returned at the expiry of the period of loan, fine of ₹1/- per day is charged.
- 4. All markings, underlining and defacing of books by any means are strictly forbidden. Fine is levied for violation of the rules.
- No student is allowed to take his/her personal books or bags in the library however note-books are allowed.





GENERAL RULES OF DISCIPLIN

To live in a society, discipline is necessary and, this is the foundation of an educational institution. This discipline is formative, not repressive, it leads the student to develop selfcontrol, which is the essence of a well ordered and successful life. Therefore, the school requires of its students to conform to certain regulations, aimed at the growth of the entire school, and more so, of the individual student.

- Non bus commuters should reach the school, at least ten minutes earlier than the ringing of the first bell.
- There will be an attendance period at the first bell before morning assembly.
- Two bells will ring before the morning assembly. As soon as the first bell goes, the students will go to their classrooms for roll call, and after the second bell, the students will march quietly and smartly in a single line to their place of assembly.
- Students should be always neatly dressed. They should come to school in proper school uniform. I-card is a part of the uniform and must be worn at all times.
- Uniform is compulsory during school hours and for all school functions including all such instances where students are representing the school outside.
- Girls are not allowed to apply henna on their hands. They are not allowed to wear earrings or rings on fingers or nose rings. However, pair of small ear study is permitted.
- Girls are required to tie their hair in two plaits with blue ribbons and girls with short hair should wear blue hair band.
- Colouring or bleaching of hair is not permitted.
- Students should behave in a refined and civilized manner in the school and adjudged by their conduct. They should greet and respect their elders/teachers wherever they meet them.
- No pupil is allowed to leave the school premises during the school hours or in the recess without the prior permission of the Principal.
- · No student is allowed to receive visitors or to make phone calls during school hours unless the matter is very urgent and he/she has the prior permission of the Principal.
- No other books and magazines are to be brought to school.
- Pupils are not permitted to bring valuables like costly watches, jewellery etc. to school.
- Students are not allowed to bring any weapons or sharp instruments, such as blades, knives, paper-scalpels, scissors etc., to school.
- Students are prohibited from bringing any publication, reference books, CD or other storage devices like pen drives or I-pods, not relevant to academic pursuits. Violation may result in suspension and/or levying of heavy fine.
- Bringing money to school is not allowed.
- Bringing mobile phones, cameras, expensive pens, etc. to school is strictly forbidden.



- Exploding crackers on any occasion or splashing colours during Holi within the school premises or in school buses is strictly forbidden.
- . Any wilful damage done by a pupil to the school building or property will be taken as serious offence and parents are liable to fulfill the loss and even may result in suspension/expulsion from school in addition to levy of heavy fine.
- Bulling and use of foul language are punishable offences.
- If a student does not improve his/her conduct or behaviour despite repeated warning, his/her name will be struck off the register.
- No student has the permission to commute to school on self-driven two/four wheelers.
- All correspondence addressed to the pupil, is subject to scrutiny by the Principal.
- Students should bring their class assignments, projects and other forms of test papers etc. signed by their parents on regular basis and get the same verified by the class teacher concerned.
- Student should write their names, classes and sections on all their belongings.
- The school reserves the right to terminate the continuance of students with unsatisfactory progress in studies or whose conduct is a bad example for others.

Note: The management of the school has the right to change the above mentioned rules any time.



Warning card will be given to a student when and if required.

Warning Card: for indiscipline, irregular attendance, late arrival, lack of proper outfit, damaging school property, neglect of daily lessons, frequent omission of home work, insolence, stealing, copying in examination or a test.

THREE WARNING CARDS CARRY A RED CARD.

A Red Card means serious action will be taken against the concerned student. It will lead to termination.

IN ADDITION TO THE WARNING CARDS THE FOLLOWING DISCIPLINARY MEASURES MAY ALSO BE ADOPTED BY THE SCHOOL IN DEALING WITH STUDENTS BEHAVING IN AN UNRULY MANNER.

- Oral warning and counselling.
- Written warning
- Detention during the break, or for whole day
- Suspension (ranging from 7 days to 30 days)
- Rustication
- Withdrawal of transport facility for misbehaviour in the school bus.


